The City of Meadville held a meeting Monday, February 14, 2022 at 6:30PM.

Those in attendance: Nelson Dinsmore, Tim Nickell, Debbie Bennett, Brandy Barclay, Brad Coin, Ruthie Munsterman

Ruthie called meeting to order.

Additions to agenda – Hach annual maintenance plan

Approval of Minutes – Nelson made motion to accept minutes as presented. Debbie 2nd. All in favor.

Public Participation – Bekah Anderson in attendance. Requested the city payment dropbox to be moved from a residential area due to safety concerns. Has issues with loose cats and dogs. Council recommended she call Tim when there's a problem. Would like to see at stop light at the school; this is not allowed by MoDot per previous requests of them.

Old Business

- Sewer project update/review – In troubleshooting phase with a couple leaks.
- Street improvements update – Nelson met with Courtney Miller with Greenhills Regional Planning Commission as the Assistant Director Jackie Spotek was not in. Jackie knows the city's plans and will discuss with Cary/Allstate Engineers who performed the street analysis recently. May get grant as soon as wastewater project/grant are closed out. March 1st is the deadline for this upcoming year. All parties are aware of deadline and will strive to complete.
- Park improvements/equipment – Will go out for bids by month end. Seeking contractor with workers compensation and liability insurance. Job will be weather permitting. Bids due by March 31, 2022. Equipment specs can be picked up at Bobbi's office.
- COVID monies – tabled until next meeting.
- Drain near 100 S Macon/tube by Baptist Church – pending better weather.
- Ordinances regarding city clerk/accountant position – tabled until next meeting.
- Candidate filing for mayor & two alderman positions closed on December 28, 2021. Seats currently held by mayor Ruthie Munsterman and aldermen Nelson Dinsmore and Brad Coin. Ruthie filed for mayor again. No one filed as candidate for alderman. Two seats opening will be filled by appointment of the mayor with advice & majority consent of the remaining aldermen per state law (MoRS 79.280). Present at the meeting were Aaron Norris & Bekah Anderson who wish to be considered for upcoming open alderman seats.
- 2021 financial audit – Field work near completion. Report should be presented March or April meeting.

New Business

- Tractor Blade - Get bids or consider buying used blade from upcoming Wes Groves sale.
- Hach annual maintenance plan - Debbie made 1st motion to accept, Brandy 2nd motion. All in favor.
