Old Business

- Sewer project update/review – From Allstate “Revised plans and specs have been sent to MDNR for review. When they are approved, we can begin preparing for bid advertisement”
- Community Betterment committee report by Nelson Dinsmore – Nothing to report.
- Painting of water building – Scrapped. Will powerwash & paint.
- Street improvements update – Allstate working on street assessment
- Stop signs at school – Tim working with company on wiring issue
- Blind spots & parking issues, lines on street – pending weather
- Meadville Community Fire District & potential land donation by city – Surveyor has been onsite & is working on final report
- Review of procurement policy - Tabled

New Business

- Swimming pools & write off for sewer – Concerned citizen has inquired about pool fill sewer write-off. Decision was made last summer to not make sewer adjustments for pool fills and council agreed this was still the desired action. All in favor.
- David Freemeyer electric service – City provides service from transformer to meter. Meter to structure hookup is on the property owner. Nelson to discuss w/ Freemeyer.
- No trespassing signs for city property – Trespassers on city property being rented. Tim to hang signs so the sheriff can be contacted.
- COVID-19 & city park closure – To remain closed for time being.
- Discharging of firearms in city limits – Public safety issue. Ordinance drafted by attorney & will be voted on at next meeting.
- City brush pile by lagoon is for lawn waste ONLY
- Bids from Smith Lawn & Tree received for line upgrades/maintenance – 3 bids were received for continued electric line upgrades, 1 related to the wastewater project. Work to lagoon bid at \$12875. Nickell Tree is the current tree trimming contractor for the city. They will complete project work at that hourly rate. Lagoon lines are top priority at this

point. Smith work must be completed by Sept 1, 2020. Debbie made motion to approve as outlined above. Brad 2nd. All in favor.

- Ditch by Beal house – Tim will dig ditch.

Tim Nickell's stuff
