Old Business

- Missing street signs- 20 blank signs have been ordered. Will take to Brookfield for completion as soon as they arrive.
- Water tower inspection- Pittsburg Tank & Tower bid reviewed by board. \$1275 cost for inspection only. They will send complete report & pictures of interior. Inspection recommended every 5-10 years. Approximately 7 years since last inspection. Sandy made the motion to approve bid, Aaron 2nd, all approved.
- New mower for next spring- Tim actively obtaining bids.
- Source water protection plan update- Still working on paperwork per Tim.
- Code enforcement- Information provided by Lisa Colson, Executive Director with Green Hills Regional Planning Commission. 21 local communities currently utilize this service. Code enforcement officer employed by GHRPC would be responsible for reviewing current city ordinances, writing citations, court appearances, etc. Board's concern for enforcement of citations with the legal system discussed. Lisa will review and reach out to county government for clarification on ensuring due process for these cases.
- New trees for city park- Will put on hold until park improvements are discussed & planned.

New Business

- Collaboration proposed with City, Meadville School, PTO & Betterment Committee. Several issues with current state of city park discussed. Board of Aldermen voiced their support of improvements needed. Meadville PTO & Betterment Committee will be researching available grants, costs, and fundraising ideas to obtain set goals.
