Old Business

- Sewer project update/review – Work in progress. 4th pay request has been received from Ross Construction & CDBG.
- Street improvements update – Nelson has not yet followed up with GHRPC but will soon. Tim talked to Allstate recently and they feel a bond issue with a tax or monthly fee would be a possible option.
- Park improvements/equipment – Equipment has been received along with an invoice. Check has been mailed & Doolin Foundation has given a grant as reimbursement for the cost. The installation has not yet been scheduled. Bobbi has emailed.
- COVID monies – per attorney recommendation, need to wait to spend given pending additional legislation.
- Drain near 100 S Macon/tube by Baptist Church – Still on Tim's list. Waiting on KC Dirtworks.
- Terry Keller lights – New transformer has been hung & pole set. Should be fixed.
- Occasional low water pressure discussed at last meeting – tabled. No other complaints.
- City clerk/accountant position – Council is reviewing ordinances & will consult with the city attorney about revising them. Working toward having a city office presence & more defined duties of city clerk/accountant positions. Council is unified in opinion the position needs to be ran in a professional & business-like manner. In interim, starting 12/1, Tim will sit in city hall office Tuesday & Thursday 8-9AM & 3:30-4:30PM to answer questions and accept payments.

- 2022 budget worksheet review – in progress. Will discuss further at next meeting and go to closed session for personnel. Council to consider various issues.
- Candidate filing for mayor & two alderman positions opens December 7 & closes on December 28, 2021. Seats currently held by mayor Ruthie Munsterman and aldermen Nelson Dinsmore and Brad Coin.
- Holiday gifts for Tim N & Bobbi – Nelson made motion to approve ham purchases for Thanksgiving & Christmas. Brandy 2nd. Debbie will purchase and be reimbursed.
