- Electric upgrades- MPUA- \$22,000 additional cost to complete. MPUA under bid the amount of hours needed to complete upgrades. Poles have been completed & wiring still needs to be completed. Requesting final estimate in writing to prevent any further discrepancies.
- Burkholder insurance claim- No further information from insurance company received. Will remove from agenda until notified of any updates.
- New city mower for next spring- Current mower bought from John Deere. Tim will obtain pricing for new mower from John Deere, Ferris, Kabota, Fries, & Pettijohn.
- City yard waste site- More instances of site being used to dump household waste. Discussion of placing cameras & another sign to make people aware they are on camera. Yard waste only!
